Carroll County Public Schools are located near both the Baltimore and Washington, D.C. metropolitan areas. The region can best be characterized as a rural area, rapidly becoming suburban. Today, over 25,200 students are enrolled in our schools, ranking us as the 10th largest school system in the state of Maryland. We are comprised of 8 high schools, including the Carroll County Career and Technology Center.

The Carroll County Public School System (CCPS) ranks as one of the top-performing school systems in the state of Maryland. Carroll County students consistently score above state and national averages on standardized student assessments. Carroll County also has one of the highest graduation rates and lowest dropout rates in the state. Grade Point Averages and Rankings

Students in CCPS receive a weighted and unweighted GPA/Class Rank determined by the final grade in each course. The dual GPA/class rank system is based on the assignment of quality points. The unweighted GPA is computed by counting all courses equally on a 4.0 scale. The weighted GPA is computed by weighing AP/Dual Enrollment courses on a 5.0 scale and honors courses on a 4.5 scale.
